REST IN LOVE

Brethren in Christ, by faith we became followers of Christ, sealed (marked and protected) by the power of the Spirit that dwells within us. We have persevered through many valleys of the shadow of death; and with each valley, the Lord has glorified himself with a breakthrough building up our faith and aligning us to his will.

Although we don't know what each passing minute will bring, we know we will have many testimonies because scripture says in Revelation 12:11 that we are overcomers by the blood of the lamb and the word of our testimony. *Amen!*

But the Scripture does not end there. The second part says

... and they did not love their lives to the death. (Rev 12:11)

Who does that remind us of? Christ! This part of the scripture assures us that we will become more like Christ, who loved us to death while he was on earth. *Praise God!*

As we build up our Faith through the word of God, prayer, praise and perseverance, the Spirit will begin to bear fruits within us. The most important fruit we can bear is love.

Love is the Kingdom of God within us (Mark 12:33-34, Luke 17:21); and as we walk in Love, everything we need will be added unto us.

Therefore, do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?'... your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added unto you.

Love is not just words, but deeds of kindness, patience, forgiveness we offer our neighbors (i.e., anybody God places in your path)

Dear children, let us not **love** with words or speech but **with actions** and in truth This is how we know that we belong to the truth and how we set our hearts at **rest** in his presence. (1 John 3:18-19)

So today, my charge to us is to let go of all our worries and Rest in Love. When we do this, we are assured of great testimonies in this world and beyond.

INTERCESSORY PRAYERS

For the next part of our prayer session, we will offer up a sacrifice of love by praying for our neighbors. We believe that God will take care of our needs just like he did for Job after he prayed for his friends.

After Job had prayed for his friends, the LORD restored his fortunes and gave him twice as much as he had before. (Job 42:10)
